**Greta** is a pluridisciplinary project in which live electronic music meets contemporary dance. We would like to share our desire to put together different ways of expressions in art. Our goal is to open people's minds to the mixing of differences, which is a great richness.

**Greta** tries to give a new look to the surrealistic period which was definitively radical at its time; it's an artistic way to visit different artistic historical concepts with the audience.

## **Project description**

Marion Faure present **Greta**, a choreographic exquisite corpse, inspired by the danced transcription of *l'homme* approximatif (Tristan Tzara).

**Cadavre exquis** or exquisite corpse: a collective collage of words or images; one player writes a word on a sheet of paper, conceals it then gives it to the next player who does not take care of this collaboration.

In our work, the materials are not gathered logically or narratively and the choreographic sentence ignores the previous picture so to give a heterogeneous structure.

Another main line is the use of objects. Marion Faure is following Marcel Duchamp and his theory of the misappropriation ("théorie du détournement"): the objects are not perceived because of their use or value but have their own personality. In this piece everything begins with flippers!

The sound device will be used to amplify, increase or contradict the choreography. Like in Marcel Duchamp's *Erratum musical* and John Cage's work, the music will be made of different collages of vinyls and tapes which will be ordered to create a new form: the rigor of the machine opposing to the chaotic movement of the contemporary world.

Moreover, by following John Cage and Merce Cunningham, music and dance will play with their instability. The previously recorded sounds will interact with the sounds produced by the movements of the body.


